The Outlet Collection at the Riverwalk (328 ft)

The nation's first upscale outlet center in a downtown setting features over 75 retailers and restaurants on the bank of the Mississippi River in the Heart of New Orleans. Major national brands include Neiman Marcus Last Call Studio, Tommy Bahama Outlet, Forever 21, Coach, the Puma Store, and Kenneth Cole. Center favorites and originals include Gap Factory Store, Aerosoles, Swim n' Sport Outlet, The Fudgery, and Café du Monde. Savor the fashion and indulge in the savings.

Fulton Alley (0.5 mi)

Creole Queen Riverboat (0.2 mi)

Audubon Aquarium of the Americas (0.3 mi)

Located on the Mississippi River adjacent to the French Quarter, Audubon Aquarium of the Americas immerses you in an underwater world. The colors of a Caribbean reef come alive in its walk-through tunnel, while the penguins and Southern sea otter enchant you with their antics. Touch a sting ray, feed a parakeet, and marvel at the gigantic sharks, tarpon, and rays in the 400,000 gallon Gulf of Mexico Exhibit. Watch for sea turtles throughout the Aquarium—as coordinator of the Louisiana Marine Mammal and Sea Turtle Rescue Program, the Aquarium prepares many of them for release to the wild.

Swamp Tours (16.7 mi with transportation from and to the hotel)

Find yourself immersed in adventure in the marshy swamplands of the Big Easy's backyard only 25-minutes away from downtown New Orleans! World War II Museum (0.8 mi)

Designated by Congress as the official WWII museum of the United States, The National WWII Museum is located in downtown New Orleans where five soaring pavilions house historical exhibits, a period dinner theater, and a 4D Steven Spielberg film recollecting the events that occurred during the war. Beyond the galleries, webinars, and online collections, patrons are offered new ways to connect to history and honor the generation that sacrificed so much to secure our freedom.

The Cafe is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week and is a place where locals indulge and guests to the city lose themselves.
