Complex Rehab Technology (CRT) includes individually configured wheelchairs, seating systems, and other adaptive equipment prescribed to meet the specific needs of people with disabilities such as ALS, cerebral palsy, and spinal cord injury. We need Congress to protect access by passing important legislation this year.

Protect Complex Rehab Wheelchairs - Bills H.R. 2293 introduced by Representatives John Larson (D-CT) and Lee Zeldin (R-NY) and S. 1223 introduced by Senators Bob Casey (D-PA) and Rob Portman (R-OH) will halt inappropriate Medicare payment cuts for critical components of Complex Rehab Manual Wheelchairs and permanently exclude them from the Competitive Bidding Program.

Create Separate Benefit Category - Bill H.R. 2408 introduced by Representatives Jim Sensenbrenner (R-WI) and Brian Higgins (D-NY) will establish a separate benefit category for CRT within Medicare to allow better access and safeguards through proper segregation and needed improvements in coverage, coding, and supplier standards.
