



Follow these steps to install the app on your mobile device and get the most useful information.

1. **Download and install the app** using 1) the QR code, 2) from the [Apple Store](#) or [Google Play](#) or 3) you can use the [Web version](#).
2. **Create your profile by using an e-mail address.** Once you have created a profile in the app, you will be able to connect it to your social networks (Facebook, LinkedIn, Google+ or Twitter). **With a profile you can:** send private messages to other user profiles, post photos and comments, rate speakers/sessions and provide feedback, and participate in Quick Polls

### Search by Keywords

Use the search option in the upper right corner of the People section to filter the attendee list by keywords.

### Filter

Choose to look through the schedule via a filter that lets you choose the conference area (workshop, paper, poster, etc.) or by attendee type (presenter, plenary speaker, exhibitor, etc.)

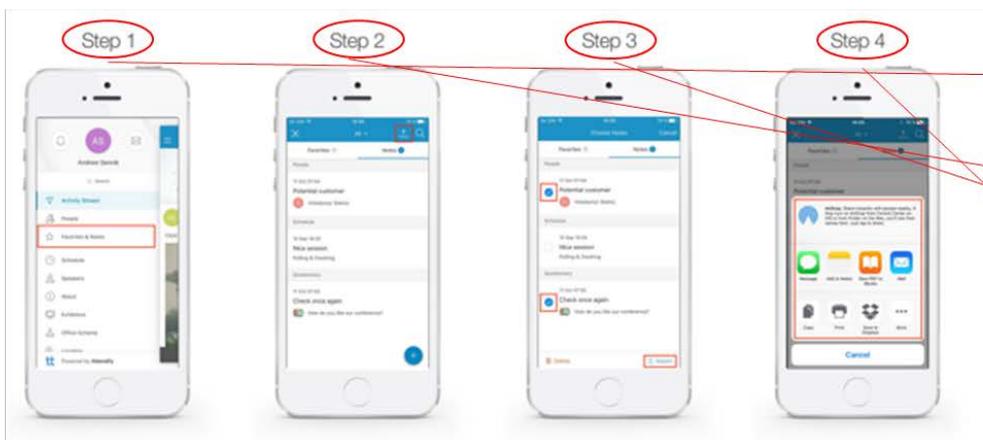
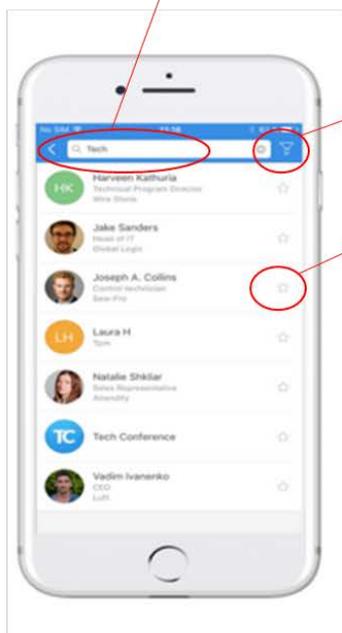
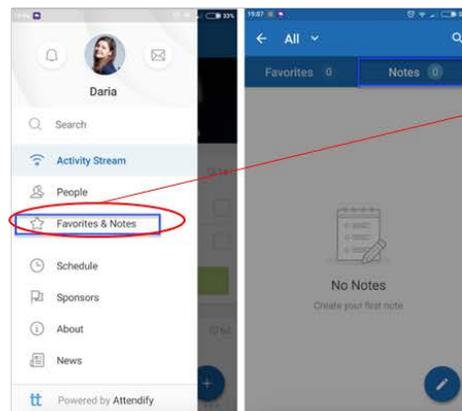
### Taking Notes

Keep track of interactions and comments. You can connect them to a specific session, attendee, speaker, location, exhibitor or sponsor. This can also be useful to track your CEUs.

1. Swipe the screen to the right to access the app menu and select Favorites & Notes.
2. Create a new Note by searching for speakers, sessions, locations and so on by typing keywords or letters. Then tap the item you'd like to add notes too.
3. Write down your Note and tap the checkmark at the top-right corner to save it. A Note will appear below **Notes** in Favorites & Notes.

### Favorites

Select events, people, sponsors, exhibitors, or any other item as a favorite by clicking the Star to the right of any item. You'll be able to set a reminder about a particular session (10, 30, or 60 minutes in advance).



### Export your notes

1. Access the section "Favorites & Notes" in the application's menu.
2. Tap the export icon in the upper-right corner of the screen.
3. Select notes you want to export.
4. Choose one of the export options.
